Summer Reading Program 2011

It was a record-breaking summer, both in temperature and in the number of books read! Congratulations, Wyomissing readers, I'm very proud of all who participated – all 468 of you! Collaboratively, an impressive 13,761 books were read. During my school visit to Wyomissing Hills Elementary Center, I made a promise. If the children read 12,000 books over the summer, a special guest and I would be sent to the DUNK TANK! Who was our special guest? It was good sports Mr. Babb, principal at West Reading Elementary Center and Mr. Blickley, Physical Education teacher at Wyomissing Hills Elementary. We'll brave the frigid water many times over, if it means children will continue reading throughout the summer, keeping their reading skills sharp.

Our theme for the summer was One World, Many Stories, exploring the diverse countries around the world. Children listened to new languages, learned of the varied clothing and customs, and experienced an introduction to geography. While these worldly concepts may seem too advanced for our young audience, exposing them to the words, concepts and pictures provides them with background knowledge – an essential component before learning begins in a structured school setting.

I was kept extremely busy throughout the summer with 54 events to prepare! A few favorites returned, including Sprinkler Day and Family Movie Nights. One of the most popular events this summer was the Harry Potter Extravaganza created and implemented by our intern, Shanna Kline. Participation at library events continues to soar. With 1,554 in attendance, this was an increase in participation of 10% versus summer of last year!

Thank you to everyone who continues to support the library (and me) through your dedicated participation! I'm looking forward to the exciting adventures in store for next summer! (The planning has already begun!)

WPL's 100th Anniversary is Approaching

The Library first opened its doors on January 21, 1913, in the Wyomissing Borough Hall and was open two evenings a week. The entire collection contained books that were donated by members of the community. On May 31, 1913, the Library purchased its first 3 books: "The Arabian Nights" edited by Kate Douglas (\$2.25), "Laddie" by Gene Stratton-Porter (\$1.25), and "The Secret Garden" by Frances Hodgson Burnett (\$1.35). 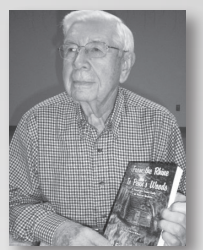
In celebration of the library's 100th Anniversary, we are planning some festivities. Stay tuned for more details as we get closer to the anniversary.

Thursday, October 13, 2011, at 7pm: Piloting Dangerous Supply Missions During World War II by Dr. Carl Frey Constein

Dr. Carl Frey Constein grew up in the town of Fleetwood during the Great Depression of the 1930s. After college, he enlisted in the Army Air Corps and flew the dangerous route over the Himalayas from India to China and back to keep the Chinese supplied during World War II. For his 96 missions as a C-46 pilot across the Himalayan 'Hump', he was awarded two Air Medals and the Distinguished Flying Cross. He later wrote three books about flying the 'Hump' in the China-Burma-India theater of operations during World War II. Join us to hear this local veteran, author, retired teacher and former Wilson School District Superintendent discuss and sign his eight published books of fiction and nonfiction.

Wednesday, October 26, 2011 at 7pm: A Look Inside Japanese Schools by Mike Miller

Mr. Miller, an art teacher at the Wyomissing Area Junior Senior High School, was selected from a national pool of 450 educators to participate in a Japan-U.S. Teacher Exchange Program for Education for Sustainable Development (ESD). The bi-nationally funded program for U.S. teachers takes place in two parts: a Joint Conference with Japanese teachers in San Francisco in May 2011, and a two-week study tour to Japan in June 2011. Teachers had the opportunity to collaborate with each other to strengthen school activities in four vital areas of EDS focus: food and sustainable nutrition, environment, energy and resources, and international understanding and cooperation.
