

Manual download using your Web browser and Windows Media Player

Search

Basic Search lets you quickly find eAudiobook titles available from your library. You can search using Full-Text, Keyword, Title, Author or Subject. Advanced Search offers Boolean operators and multiple fields, as well as drop-down search parameters (Title, Author, Full-Text, Keyword, Subject, Publisher or ISBN).

The eAudiobooks Center allows you to limit your search within eAudiobook content and browse featured titles. You may link to the eAudiobook Center from the NetLibrary home page in the right navigation pane under the heading, "Use our Subject Centers and Databases."

Checkout

- Find an eAudiobook title you want to check out.
- From the search results, click on "Download this Audiobook."
- Select the Check Out & Download CD Quality link under the Manual Download Options.

Download

- Select the Save Download option (not the Open option).
- Save the file on your computer.
- Play the file on your computer or transfer it to a portable device using Windows Media Player 10 or higher.

Transfer to a portable device

To transfer an eAudiobook file to your portable device:

1. Connect your portable device to your computer following the device's instructions.

2. Open Windows Media Player (WMP) 10 or higher.
3. In the File menu, open the downloaded file. This activates the license and begins to play the eAudiobook.
4. WMP 10: Click the Library tab. WMP 11: Click the Sync tab (not the drop-down list below the tab).
5. WMP 10: Find your eAudiobook title in the Playlist. Then Select Sync List in the drop-down menu above the right pane. WMP 11: Click Now Playing in the menu on the left.
6. Click and drag your eAudiobook title into the right pane.
7. Click the Start Sync button located below the right pane.
8. When synchronizing is 100 percent complete, disconnect your portable device following its instructions.
9. Close Windows Media Player.
10. Enjoy listening to the eAudiobook on your portable device.

How to renew

The license for your downloaded eAudiobook will expire at the end of the checkout period.

1. Renew the license on the NetLibrary Web site.
 - a. Log in to your account.
 - b. Click on the Checked Out Items link in the top right corner of the page.
 - c. Find the eAudiobook title you wish to renew and click on the Download this Audiobook link.
 - d. Click on the Renew your Checkout link in the Manual Download Options. (No Download. Only license to play file).
 - e. This will renew your license and extend your checkout period.
2. Transfer the eAudiobook to your portable device to renew the license there.

eAudiobooks from NetLibrary

eAudiobooks from NetLibrary are digital audiobooks available from your library over the Internet. You can search for, check out and download eAudiobooks to a computer or portable device.

You can listen to eAudiobooks on your computer, or on a wide range of portable devices that support playback of secure or protected wma files—including portable music players and portable media centers from Archos, Creative Labs, Samsung, Toshiba and other manufacturers.

You can transfer an eAudiobook to your portable device using the NetLibrary Media Center application or Windows Media Player software. Then you can enjoy listening to the eAudiobook anywhere.

What You Need

To go portable, you need a portable listening device and you need NetLibrary Media Center or Windows Media Player, version 10.0 or higher.

The portable device must support playback of secure or protected wma files and 32 kbps files. For an optimal listening experience, the portable device should have a storage capacity of at least 512 MB and include features for playing long files and returning to a designated place in a file such as full time-stamping and bookmarking.

If you want to install NetLibrary Media Center, your computer must have Microsoft Windows Vista with Service Pack 1 or later or Windows XP with Service Pack 2 or later. In addition, your computer must meet the installation requirements provided in the Media Center area of NetLibrary Help.

Overview

You can search for, check out and download eAudiobooks using either of two methods:

- Automated download using the NetLibrary Media Center application (if your library supports the Media Center).
- Manual download using your Web browser, the www.netlibrary.org Web site and Windows Media Player 10 or higher.

You must first create a free NetLibrary account with the Wyomissing Public Library.

1. Go to the library's homepage:
www.wyopublib.org
2. Click on the "Links" button.
3. Click on the "Recorded Books" button.
4. Follow the instructions.

New users:

1. Enter your library card number in the designated place.
2. Create a username and password.

Returning users:

1. Click on the link for returning users
2. Enter your username and password where it is indicated.

You can log into the library's eAudiobook collection from any computer with Internet access.

Automated download using NetLibrary Media Center

It's as easy as connect, click, and listen.

Connect

Install Media Center on your computer.

First log in to www.netlibrary.org. Click Help, review the Media Center installation requirements, and follow the installation procedure. Then launch Media Center from your desktop, log in and use the Home, Browse and Search tabs to explore and preview your library's eAudiobooks and add eAudiobooks to your favorites.

Click

- Click Transfer to Computer to listen on your computer.
- Connect your portable device and click Transfer to Portable to listen on your portable device.

Listen

Enjoy the eAudiobook on your portable device or use the Media Center player controls to listen on your computer.

Use Checked Out Items in the My Stuff tab to:

- Resume listening to an eAudiobook from the point where you last stopped.
- Transfer an eAudiobook to your portable device.
- Renew the checkout to extend the listening period, then transfer the eAudiobook to your portable device to renew the checkout there.

Use Favorites in the My Stuff tab to:

- Transfer a favorite eAudiobook to your portable device or computer.
- Preview a favorite eAudiobook.
- Remove an eAudiobook from your favorites.
