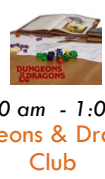

Join Melanie Bernik as she leads this fun and relaxing yoga class for preschoolers. Registration is required.

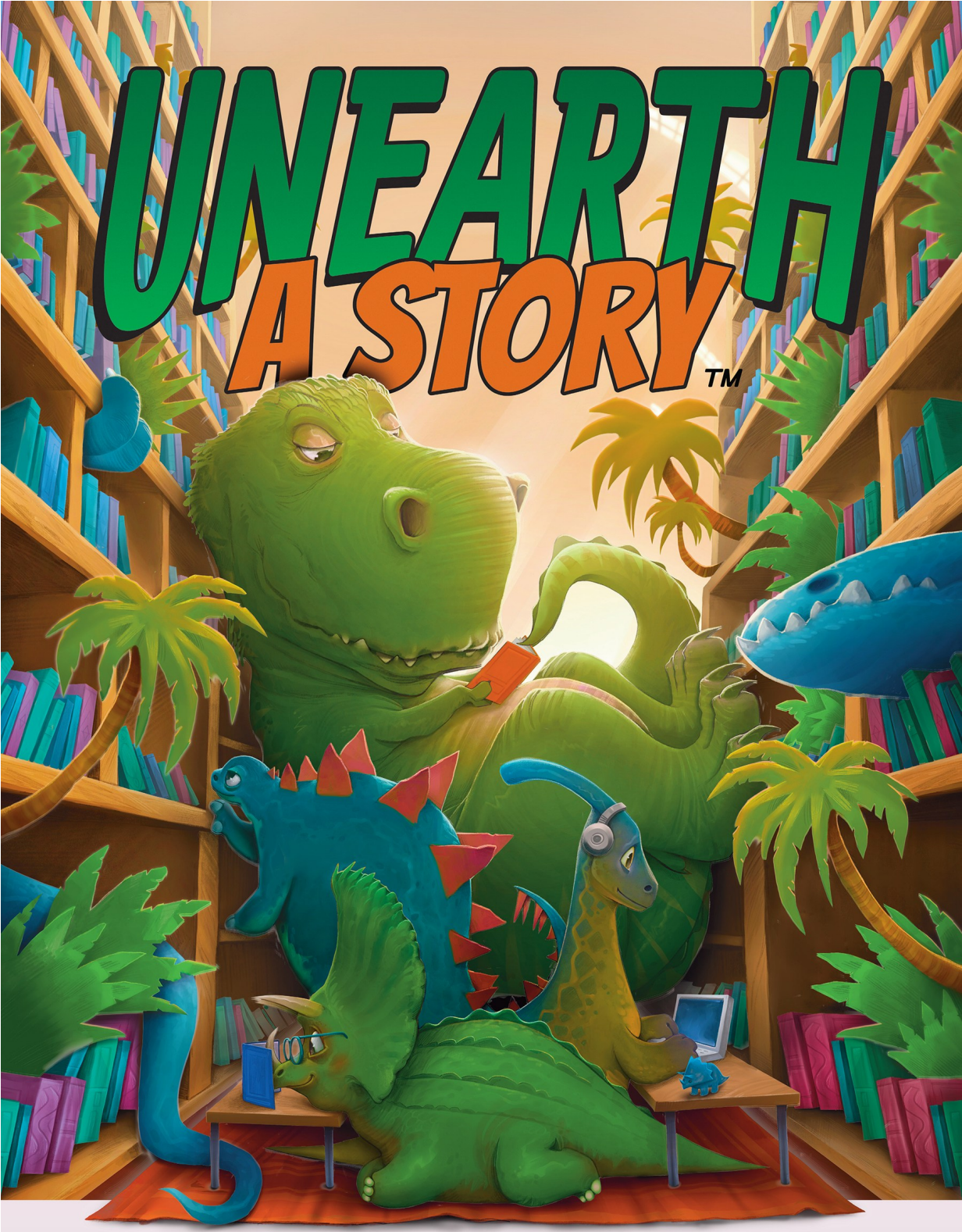
SUMMER BLOCK PARTY & YARD SALE

WHAT IS THE SUMMER QUEST PROGRAM?
The 2026 Summer Quest Program encourages children & teens to read and learn throughout the summer for FUN. The library offers dozens of FREE programs each month to foster a love of reading, and engage kids in learning. The program runs from Monday, June 15 to Saturday, August 8 (8 weeks).

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?
Any child or teen from birth through age 18. Children may either read books on their own or listen to books being read to them.
